The successful candidate is expected to work directly with children referred by Supported Child Development as well as a part of team of educators, attend meetings and liaise with Supported Child Development and other service providers, and follow guidance provided by the Early Years Coordinator and service providers (Occupational therapist, Physiotherapist, Supported Child Development Consultant and other providers as needed).

**Hours:** Tuesday and Thursday 9:15am to 1:15pm. 8 hours/week plus 2 hours/month for meetings.

**Rate:** Band C2 \$21.36 - \$22.11 based on qualifications and experience plus \$4/hour as per the MCFD Wage Enhancement

**Benefits:** This is a term position and therefore will receive an additional 4% in lieu of vacation time

**Term period: September 5<sup>th</sup>, 2023, to June 28<sup>th</sup>, 2024**

**Conditions:** Subject to continued funding from BC Centre for Ability- Supported Child Development Program.

- Minimum 2 years of experience in licensed childcare
- Minimum age 19 years (as per licensing regulations)
- Excellent communication and interpersonal skills
- Ability to take initiative and work independently as well as a part of a team
- Demonstrated organizational skills
- Ability to work in a multicultural and inclusive environment
- Second language is an asset
- Passion for supporting and advocating for children and families

- Passion for collaborative, emergent and responsive curriculum
- Working Knowledge of the BC Early Learning Framework and the Reggio Emilia Approach
