The Preschool Educator is expected to participate in professional development opportunities, both in-house and across the ECE community and to collaborate with MPNH Family Resource Programs.

Hours: Monday to Friday. 8:45am to 1:45pm plus curriculum planning and team meeting time for a total of 27 hours per week.

Rate: Band C2 - \$21.36 – \$22.11 based on qualifications and experience plus \$4/ Wage Enhancement.
